Associate Membership, offers an excellent opportunity for golfers with flexible schedules (\* see below for allowable times of play).

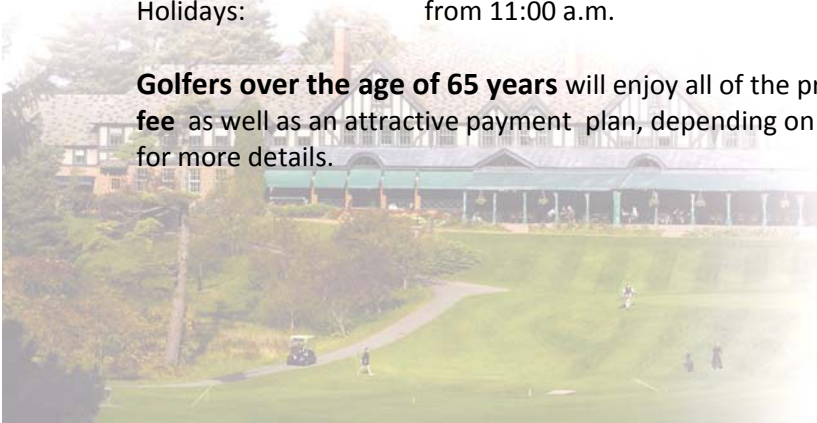

### **Associate membership—Trial Option**

You now have the opportunity to “give us a try”! Upon completion of all the usual membership application process and being accepted to the Club, Associates may now elect to pay a fee to defer their permanent commitment to the Club for up to 60 days during which time their privileges will be in effect. For a fee of \$1500, payable upon joining, you can enjoy all of the options of the Associate membership for two months. If you choose to remain a member after 60 days of membership, you will be billed your first installment of the Entrance Fee and a \$500 credit will go towards the prorated annual fee for the remainder of the season.

This new alternative offers new members the opportunity to see for themselves why our members believe this is the best private golf club in the region. We believe that once you experience the Royal Ottawa Golf Club, you will want to remain part of the Royal Family.

### **Intermediate Membership ( 21—32 years old)**

Intermediate membership is the best value for young professionals, age 21 to 32 years. Enjoy playing on your schedule, as often as you want – with an outstanding payment plan, interest free, payable over as many as 14 years, depending on age at joining. An Intermediate who resigns in writing before their thirty-second birthday will not be required to pay any unpaid portion of their entrance fees .

When Intermediate members reach the age of thirty-two, their names will be placed on the waiting list, and they shall automatically become Ordinary members in their turn.

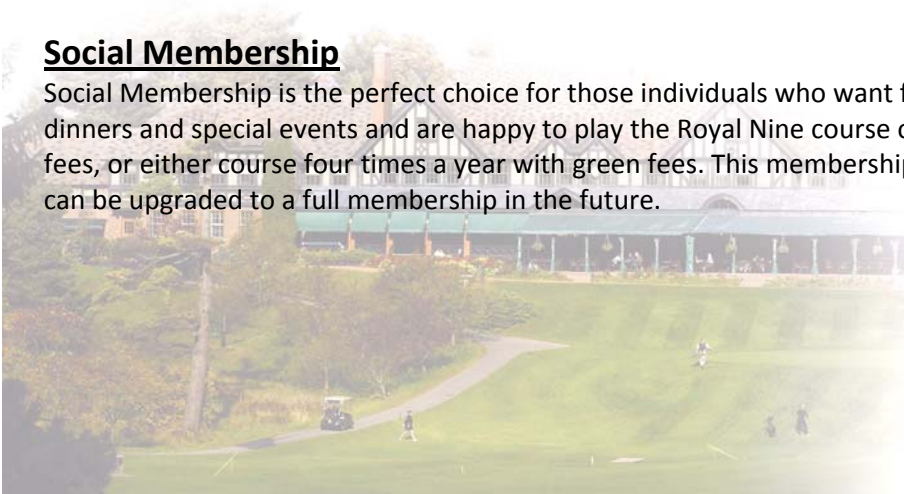
### **Special Membership (Ordinary and Associate)**

Special members are members whose occupation or whose spouse's occupation is, in the opinion of the Board, of such a nature as to indicate that their period of residence within *160 kilometers from the Club* may be of a relatively short duration. At the end of five years from the date of such admission, the Special member's name is placed on the Ordinary or Associate members waiting list (if one such exists), and they shall automatically become an Ordinary or Associate member, as the case may be, in their turn.

They shall have the same Clubhouse and playing privileges as Ordinary or Associate members, as the case may be, but shall not be entitled to nominate, vote or hold office.

### **Social Membership**

Social Membership is the perfect choice for those individuals who want full access to the Clubhouse for lunches, dinners and special events and are happy to play the Royal Nine course on Sundays after 3:00 p.m. with no green fees, or either course four times a year with green fees. This membership is a great introduction to the Club and can be upgraded to a full membership in the future.



### **Privileged Membership (Ordinary, Associate and Social)**

Privileged members (Ordinary, Associate and Social) pay only an Annual fee while serving in the following positions:

- i. Current ministers of the Crown, Leader of the Official Opposition and their spouses;
- ii. Current Secretary to the Governor General and his/her spouse;
- iii. Ambassadors, High Commissioners and other Heads of Missions accredited to the Government of Canada, and up to two other senior members of their diplomatic staff and their spouses;
- iv. members of temporary Commissions, Committees and other investigative bodies, appointed by the Government of Canada, who do not normally reside within 160 kilometers of the Club and their spouses.

Privileged membership will cease when the member ceases to be in one of the above categories. They will have the same Clubhouse and playing privileges as Ordinary, Associate or Social members, as the case may be, but will not be entitled to nominate, vote or hold office.

### **Junior Membership ( 6—21 years old)**

Junior Membership (6 years to 21 years) will suit young golfers who are relatives of a member and want to learn the game at a prestigious course, with qualified professionals – or just enjoy a fun-round of golf with family!

As well, a total of 30 Junior members, ages ten years or over, who are not relatives of a member, may be admitted, provided they are proposed by an Ordinary or Associate member who assumes full responsibility for the non-related Junior.

Junior members hours of play: Please see Member's Handbook or contact the Proshop for individual Junior playing privileges depending on age and handicap.

Upon completion of the Application Requirements, all candidates will be considered for membership by the Membership Committee and Board of Management, their names will be circulated to the Membership, and then approved by the Board of Management. This process can take up to 6 weeks.
